

This year, Friday 20th, the Club welcomes Robert Eddlestone, Chairman of Maritime History North to address Members and Guests. His address is entitled "Trafalgar - A New Perspective" which is based on the 200th anniversary research of The Society for Nautical Research.

Bob has a passion and fascination for all aspects of the sailing ship from their hulls to their sails. As a Midshipman 1st Lieutenant in the Royal Navy Bob circumnavigated the world. He spent 32 years in the RNR much of that time in minesweepers finishing his last tactical command of 14 MCMFV's on a NATO exercise clearing the Channel for the replenishment of Europe; retiring as Captain Sea Training (R). Over recent years Bob has used his experience and knowledge to give talks on The SNR's 2005 Battle of Trafalgar research. His historical life is very much naval but has recently expanded to include military.


